Obituary

The death of George Irving Aylesworth, a respected resident of Cooperstown, occurred at Thanksgiving Hospital last Wednesday morning [March 6], at eight o'clock, of Bright's disease. Mr. Aylesworth was born in the town of Maryland, March 9, 1839, and resided there until he was about 22 years old. In 1862 he married Miss Julia L. Pierce of Cooperstown, and soon after came to this village, where he has since resided. For many years Mr. Aylesworth was employed as a painter by the Clark estate. He is survived by his wife, one brother, C. M. Aylesworth, of Des Moines, Iowa, one sister, Mrs. Elvira Bailey, of Mansfield, Pa., and a daughter, Mrs. A. L. Reynolds of Cooperstown. The funeral was held Friday afternoon [March 8] at two o'clock, the Rev. Mr. [Wm. G.] Cortright of the Universalist church officiating, with interment in Lakewood cemetery.
