HOWARD W. BACON

Howard W. Bacon of Salisbury Center died at the Little Falls Hospital Friday noon following a heart attack, at his Salisbury home on Christmas Eve. Mr. Bacon made his summer home at Spafford, Onondaga county, where he was born February 2, 1872. He made his winter home at Salisbury Center. He was a member of the Macabee lodge at Spafford and attended the Universalist church. On April 25, 1935, he married Florence Avery McComber, who survives him, along with three sons, Ellis of Richfield Springs, Lester of Spafford and Leonard of McGraw. One brother, Burdette, of Florida.

There was a prayer service at the home in Salisbury Sunday at 2:30, conducted by the Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Mouton of the local Universalist church. [On] Monday the body will be taken to Scott, N.Y., where the funeral services will be held in the Methodist church with the Rev. C. A. Moulton officiating, at 1:30. Burial will be made in the Borodino cemetery at that place.
