MRS. MARY K. BACON

Mrs. Mary Krank Bacon, widow of the late Gary S. Bacon, died Monday in Buffalo in her 69th year. Surviving are her two children, Rosabel E. Bacon and Gary S. Bacon.

Before her marriage, Mrs. Bacon, then Mary Kraut, was proprietor of a millinery store on North Main Street, where the Citizens National Bank building now stands. Her husband, a member of the well known Bacon family of this vicinity, was the owner of a bottling works until his death nearly twenty years ago. He built the present Meland house on North Main St. across the canal and Mrs. Bacon and her children continued to live there for several years after his death. Subsequently they moved to Jamestown, N.Y., and then to Buffalo.

Mrs. Bacon's body has been brought to the Merrill Funeral Home at 10 East State Street, where it will repose until the funeral service at 3:00 p.m. this Thursday at the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church, of which she was a former member. Burial will be in Mount Albion Cemetery.
