Mrs. Caroline Hicks Bailey, a former resident of Victor, died suddenly at the home of her cousin, Mrs. Frank A. Perhamus, in Caledonia, on Wednesday night, July 10th. Mrs. Bailey had been a guest of her cousin for about three weeks, having come from her home in Kalamazoo, Mich., to visit relatives and friends in this section, and she had written to Victor friends that she would soon come here for a visit. Since her arrival in Caledonia she had not been in her usual health, and on Monday, July 8, she was stricken with paralysis, and passed away without regaining consciousness.

Caroline Hicks was born at Baptist Hill on December 11, 1840. In her young womanhood she became the wife of Walter Everett [Evarts], who died at their home in Bristol many years ago. An only child, a daughter, died at the age of 19 years. About 14 years ago Mrs. Everett was married to Albert Bailey of Victor, who passed away five years ago. A year later Mrs. Bailey sold her home here and went to Kalamazoo to make her home with a niece, Mrs. Mary Nichols.

Funeral services were held in the Universalist church in Bristol at 3 o'clock on Friday afternoon, Rev. O. [Otis] F. Alvord officiating. Interment was made in the family lot at Bristol.
