Special funeral services were held Wednesday night at Jeffrey's chapel on East avenue, by the employees of Garson, Meyer & Company, over the remains of their fellow workman, George Baker, whose death occurred from paralysis, with which he was stricken about a week ago. The young man was the last surviving member of his family, having buried his mother but two weeks previously. The services were in charge of Rev. Isaac P. Coddington, of the First Universalist Church. A quartette of fellow employees, Harry Moll, John Bauer, Frank Covill and Roy Demerest, sang "Nearer My God to Thee." There were many beautiful floral pieces, among them one from the Clothing Cutters' Union of this city.
