The death of Mrs. Hannahette Baker, widow of J. H. Baker, occurred Tuesday forenoon at her home in the town of Carlton following a long illness. She was born in Chautauqua county, January 16, 1835, and came to Albion at an early age with her parents. She had been a resident of the town of Carlton since her marriage, which took place in 1852. She was a member of the Pullman Memorial Universalist church of Albion, the Carlton branch of the Woman's Christian Temperance Union and of the Fairhaven branch of the Good Templars. She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Myron E. Eggleston of Carlton and Mrs. Harry B. Lattin of Gaines, three grandsons and a greatgrandson.
