H. T. BAKER, VETERAN, DIES AT AGE OF 84

Henry T. Baker, for seventeen years a resident of Syracuse, died at 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the residence of his daughter, Mrs. F. P. Doane, No. 119 Holland street, at the age of 84 years. Mr. Baker was a veteran of the Civil War, and prior to coming to Syracuse resided at Newark. He was a member of the First Universalist Church and of Root Poet of the G.A.R. For many years Mr. Baker had a blacksmith and wagon shop in Newark. Surviving him, besides his daughter, is one son, George H. Baker of Rensselaer. A funeral service will be held at 11 o'clock Friday morning at the home of Mrs. Doane. Rev. Dr. F. W. Betts will officiate. The body will be taken to Newark for interment by Fairchild & Fancher, undertakers.
