Mrs. Howard N. Baker

The death of Mrs. Howard N. Baker occurred at her home in East James Street at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, June 17th. Though ailing for some time, Mrs. Baker had been seriously ill but a week. The funeral will be held at the M. E. Church at 3:30 Thursday afternoon, the Reverend E. S. Bebee and the Reverend M. D. Sill of the Methodist Church officiating. Interment will be made in Lakeview Cemetery.

Mrs. Baker was Lucy A. Johnson, daughter of Lyman and Mary Johnson, and was born in Burlington Flats on July 28, 1861. She married Howard N. Baker on October 20, 1880. Three years ago Mr. and Mrs. Baker removed to this village from the farm on the west side of Canadarago Lake. Mrs. Baker was a member of the Universalist Church of Schuyler Lake.

There survive the husband, three children, Mrs. Carl Wing, Miss Mildred L. Baker and Edward D. Baker, and ten grandchildren.
