Mary Elizabeth Hudson Baker, widow of Rovillo Baker, died at her home four miles west of this village at four o'clock on Tuesday morning, October 25th. She had suffered from heart trouble for about six months but had been confined to her bed for only two weeks. She was the daughter of Matthew and Huldah Hudson, pioneers of the town of Covington, where she was born in September, 1835. On April 17, 1857, she was married to Rovillo Baker and went to live on his farm the "Transit," where she had since resided. Mr. Baker died twenty years ago. Mrs. Baker is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Estella Shepard, with whom she made her home, and three grandchildren. Funeral services were held at her late home at 2 o'clock on Thursday afternoon, Rev. Harry M. Wright, pastor of the Universalist church at Batavia, officiating. Burial was in the Oatka Valley cemetery.
