Mrs. H. B. Baldwin, 61, Dies; Wife of Company President

Whitesboro—Mrs. Hazel H. Baldwin, 61, of 8 Indian Mound Road, wife of Howard B. Baldwin, president and general manager of the Utica Dunlop Tire & Rubber Co., plant, died Friday in Buffalo General Hospital.

Mrs. Baldwin was born and educated in Utica, daughter of Arthur E. and Louise Pitman Hopkins, and was married in 1932.

She was financial secretary and clerk for the trustees board of the Church of the Reconciliation [Universalist] and a member of the church's women's society. Mrs. Baldwin was also a member of the Women of Rotary.
