Mrs. Burt Bale of Ridgeway Dies

LYNDONVILLE—Mrs. Burt Bale, 61, a resident of the Town of Ridgeway, died Monday (March 9, 1959) in Roswell Park Memorial Institute, Buffalo, after a long illness.

Mrs. Bale was born in Lockport May 4, 1897, the daughter of Charles and Amelia Smith Sherman. She was married in 1920 and lived with her husband in Ridgeway since that time.
