George W. Barber

George W. Barber, for many years an esteemed citizen of Clarendon, passed away at his home on the Manning Road on Thursday, January 26, following a long illness.

Mr. Barber was born December 22, 1857, in Barre but had resided in Clarendon for more than fifty years. On January 27, 1885, he was united in marriage to Miss Lucie E. Boots, who survives him. He also leaves one daughter, Mrs. Eva A. Butler, and four grandchildren, Nedra, June, Dorothy and Dean Butler, all of East Bethany; one brother, Fred W. Barber of Holley and one sister, Mrs. Hattie Woodward of Medina.

He was a member and trustee of the Clarendon Universalist church, one of the trustees of the Clarendon Community Organization and an assessor of the town of Clarendon. Upright and just in all his dealings he was highly respected throughout the community, while his genial and kindly nature won for him the warm friendship of all with whom he came in contact.

Funeral services were held from the home Sunday afternoon, Rev. L. H. Robinson officiating, with interment in Hillside cemetery.
