OBITUARY.

Monday afternoon, after an illness of several years, Mrs. Sarah Curtis Barnes died in this city. Mrs. Barnes was born at Morrisville, Madison county, 68 years ago and spent the earlier years of her life in the West. In 1868 she returned to the East, moving to Utica in 1875 and continuing to reside here. For many years Mrs. Barnes had been an invalid, and while this fact necessarily narrowed the circle of her acquaintance, there are still many who sincerely mourn her loss. She leaves three sons, Willie G. of New York, Horace F. of Peoria, Ill., and A. [Albert] L. Barnes of this city. One brother, Orville Curtis, of Sterling, N. Y., also survives.
