

[Barney, Margery Faville]

DOLGEVILLE

—This village lost a sweet and kindly soul when Mrs. Margery Barney passed away last Wednesday at her home on North Main street, after a lifelong residence of 84 years in this community. She had been ill since the early part of last January, due to a stroke of apoplexy. She was born here July 18, 1840, and was a daughter of Reuben and Nancy Cramer Faville. Her grandfather, John Faville, was the first settler in this vicinity, in 1795. She was married in 1862 to Dr. A. G. Barney, who practiced medicine here for many years and whose death occurred in 1888. The deceased was a charter member of the local Eastern Star chapter. She was also a member of the Women's Auxiliary of the American Legion. She attended the Universalist church. Mrs. Barney is survived by three sons, Dr. Fred M. Barney, Dwight F. Barney and Leon G. Barney, and by a daughter, Mrs. Ben R. Faville; and by a grandson, Rush Faville, all of this village. A brother, Captain Frank Faville, preceded her in death by only a couple of weeks. The funeral was held from the late home at 3 o'clock Saturday afternoon, Rev. C. A. Moulton of the Universalist church officiating, and interment was made in the local cemetery.
