Milan M. Barney of West Union died today (Aug. 21, 1957) in the Bath Veterans Center Hospital following a short illness.

Born March 31, 1888, he was a son of the late Delwin and Susan Hall Barney of West Union.

He was a veteran of World War I, serving 13 months overseas with Co. B, 303rd Ammunition Train. He was discharged May 28, 1919.

A trustee of the Whitesville Universalist Church for 17 years, he was also a past commander, past adjutant and honorary life member of the Robert E. James Post, American Legion of Whitesville; honorary life member of Whitesville Rod and Gun Club; [and] Greenwood Grange. He was also a past chaplain of Allegany County American Legion.

He married Miss Ora L. Graves, Aug. 21, 1925, who survives.

Other survivors include two brothers, Mason H. and Harry I. Barney of International Falls, Minn.; two sisters, Mrs. Mary E. Coats and Mrs. Nora Heselton of Whitesville; and [an] aunt, Mrs. Sarah Barney of Mt. Ranier, Md.; several cousins including Miss Emily Barney of West Union.

Services will be held at the Wildman funeral Home in Whitesville at 2 p.m. Saturday, with burial in Woodlawn Cemetery in Wellsville.
