DIED OF HEMORRHAGE

Philander Barrett, well-known in this city, died very early Wednesday morning, Dec. 24th, of hemorrhage of the stomach. He was only 48 years of age, and leaves a widow [Martha] and daughter of seventeen to mourn his loss. His remains were taken to Webster, his former home, for burial on Friday. The funeral services were conducted by Dr. [Asa] Saxe [pastor of the Universalist church], of this city. The deceased was brother to Geo. W. and Z. Barrett, of Nunda, and was one of the best known horse dealers in western New York. He was highly respected by all who knew him.—
