Died— At his home in Bristol, on the evening of Thursday, the 26th ult., Henry Barringer, Jr., aged 57 years. Thus has another active citizen of our town been called away in the midst of a busy life. Mr. Barringer was attacked with the disease (pneumonia) which so suddenly terminated his life while in Canandaigua attending Court as a juror. He stayed at the post of duty for several days when he ought to have been at home and in bed, and when he yielded it was but to come home to die. His death has left a void that can never be filled in his family, and it is sadly felt in the community in which most of his life had been spent, for he was a kind husband, an indulgent father, an obliging neighbor, a good citizen and an honest man. He left a widow and one daughter, who have, as they most richly deserve, the heartfelt sympathy of their many friends. His funeral was attended at the Universalist Church on Sunday the 1st inst., and a sermon was preached to a crowded house by Rev. H.[Henry] Jewell.
