Died. BARRUS—In this village, July 11, 1891, Mrs. Nancy J. Losee, widow of the late Alvin Barrus, in the eightieth year of her age.

The deceased was born April 5, 1812. Her married life began in the year 1833. She was the mother of two sons and two daughters, all of whom survive her. She wisely ordered the affairs of her household and was thoroughly devoted to the welfare of her family; and the many years of her pilgrimage were largely given to the comfort of others. Although it was her fortune to labor that her home might be pleasant and her family glad of heart, it was the easy labor of industry and love, and it was always her privilege to speak of her life as one of contentment and happiness. She became a member of the Universalist Church in this village at the time of its organization [1833] and in all her [ways?] she illustrated the spirit of the christian law of helpfulness. During her protracted illness she was tenderly cared for by her children, where gentle and faithful ministrations greatly alleviated her suffering. She leaves to her family and friends a legacy of a pleasant memory.
