Death of Mrs. Laura Bassett

Mrs. Laura Bassett, who had been ill about two weeks with pneumonia, died at her home on Thursday, aged 71 years. Mrs. Bassett was born in Kendall in 1840, and her maiden name was Miss Laura Clark. In 1869 she moved to Chicago, residing there nine years, then moved to LaPorte, Ind., where she made her home until moving to Albion two years ago. She was a prominent member of St. Paul's Universalist church in Chicago. She is survived by one son, W. L. Bassett, of this village, and one nephew, Marshall S. Marsh, of Chicago. The funeral service on Sunday afternoon, conducted by Rev. C [Charles] H. Vail [Universalist], was private, and the burial was in the beautiful family plot at Mt. Albion.
