Middleport Woman Succumbs to Old Age Infirmities
Funeral Will Be Held Tomorrow For Mrs. Caroline Bathrick, 89 Years Old

Ill the past two months of old age infirmities, Mrs. Caroline Bathrick, 89, a lifelong resident of Middleport and vicinity, died yesterday noon at her late home, 12 North Vernon street, Middleport.

Mrs. Bathrick was born in Hartland, had resided the past 27 years in the home where death occurred, and for many years led an active life in church and social circles, having been a member of the First Universalist church and its social circle. She was a long time critic of [for] the Middleport Study club, and for over a quarter of a century secretary of the Woman's Christian Temperance Union.

The widow of William Bathrick, the deceased is survived by one brother, Adelbert Lum, and one sister, Mrs. Adella Clark of Middleport, and ten nephews and nieces.

The funeral will be conducted tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, daylight saving time, at the home, and at 3 at the Middleport Universalist church, by the Rev. Donald K. Evans. Burial will be in Hartland Central cemetery.
