Having been left an orphan at a very early age, thereby losing the influence of a mother, who might possibly have changed the character of his whole life, he lived with his grandparents and they too passed away, after that making his home with relatives and friends. A few years since he was married to Miss Etta Simmons. His life at times has been somewhat changeable, but at last he had matured into a bright, upright and industrious young man. Having suffered for nearly six months of that dreadful disease, consumption, he quietly breathed his last Saturday, June 28, leaving a devoted wife and many friends to mourn his early death. The funeral services were held at the Universalist church on Monday, the Rev. E. B. Barber officiating.
