MRS. CARRIE L. BEADLE

Mrs. Carrie Loomis Beadle, widow of Charles W. Beadle, died in the Clarke Nursing Home in this village, September 25. She was the daughter of Daniel and Sybil Loomis and was born in the town of Richfield, July 28, 1865. She attended the Richfield Spring Seminary and later taught in Cassville and Richfield. Her marriage to Mr. Beadle took place in her home, October 28, 1891. For ten years they operated the Loomis Homestead Farm, prior to moving to Richfield. Mr. Beadle died December 24, 1938.

In recent years, Mrs. Beadle had resided with her son, Howard Beadle and in various nursing homes in this area. She was a former member of the Universalist Church in Richfield [until it closed], and later attended St. Luke's Church in Richfield. Mrs. Beadle was a former Charter member of the Richfield Grange, and a former member of Arbutus Chapter, OES and of Ganowauges Chapter, DAR.

She is survived by her son Howard and by a grandson, Robert O. Beadle and by two great grandchildren, Robert, Jr., and Katherine Beadle. The funeral will be held at the McGrath Funeral Home, Tuesday at 2:30 o'clock, the Rev. Daniel T. Hill officiating, and the burial will be in Twilight Rest Cemetery, Richfield.
