HARRY D. PECK [SIC] OF FORT PLAIN IS TAKEN BY DEATH

Fort Plain, April 4.—Harry D. Beck, 65, died Thursday at the home of his son, Garner A. Beck, 14 Prospect Street, Fort Plain, following a short illness.

He was born in Nelliston June 23, 1881, son of Charles and Elizabeth Dahlen Beck, and all of his life was spent in this section. As an athlete he was known throughout the Mohawk Valley for many years. He was employed by the Beech-Nut Packing Company, Canajoharie, retiring about two years ago.

He was a member of the Universalist Church of Fort Plain. His wife was Elma E. Green, who died in January, 1945.

Survivors are one son, Garner A. Beck, Fort Plain; two daughters, Mrs. Thomas Carbone, Phoenix, Ariz.; and Mrs. Bette Ingersoll, New York City, and two grandchildren.

The body was taken to the Gray funeral home on Willett Street, Fort Plain, where the funeral will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Warren Lovejoy, pastor of the Universalist Church, officiating. Interment will be made in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
