DIED—At his residence in Sullivan, Feb. 15, Dr. SOLOMON BEEBE, aged 62 years. His death was occasioned by a blow from some part of the harness, suddenly and very forcibly stripped from one of the horses attached to the sleigh on which he was sitting, by coming in contact with a team passing rapidly in another direction. The wound was over one eye, by which the right quarter of the scull [skull] was slightly raised—it was not at first deemed fatal, and he continued in the full exercise of reason from Saturday afternoon until about ten o'clock on Sunday, a.m. He expired on Monday afternoon.

Dr. Beebe was for several years a member of the Presbyterian church in Lenox, but became a believer in the doctrine of universal salvation about sixteen years since. Intelligent, active and persevering, he was a most devoted friend, and a faithful and able friend of the doctrine he professed. A sympathizing multitude bore witness at his funeral to his many virtues.
