DEATHS.

Mrs. Belknap has left a large circle of relations and friends, to mourn her departure. Her life should be measured by deeds. For though her earthly pilgrimage was short, her virtuous life, amiable manners, and inoffensive deportment, will render her memory sacred to all who knew her; and around the grave of this affectionate daughter, beloved wife and mother, and the once only, but now departed sister, will fond remembrance delight to linger. Her funeral was attended at the Falls, on the Tuesday following her death, and a sermon was delivered on the occasion by the writer. Although she died in the faith of the "restitution of all things," yet the Baptist church was, in Christian kindness, opened for the occasion. She was buried beside her infant child, in the dooryard of her father's house, in Fairfield.
