Dolgeville, Oct. 13—Following an extended illness, Miss Charlotte Bellinger died early this morning at her home on South Main Street. Miss Bellinger was born in Oswego, June 1, 1857, and was a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Ephraim Keller. Her mother died when she was an infant and she was adopted by the late Mr. and Mrs. Hiram Bellinger, who resided for many years just outside this village on the Little Falls road. All of her life since childhood was spent in Dolgeville and vicinity.

The deceased was a member of the Universalist Church and of the Ladies' Aid Society. She was a good neighbor, quiet, unassuming and much devoted to her home, and was loved and respected by all who enjoyed the pleasure of her acquaintance.

Surviving are two brothers, Jerome Keller of Joplin, Mo., and John of Stratford, and a niece, Mrs. Mabel Hutchinson of Mexico, Oswego County.

The funeral will be held from the home at 2:30 Thursday afternoon, Rev. C. A. Moulton of the Universalist Church officiating, and interment will be made in the local cemetery.
