J. P. BELLINGER—

Jeram P. Bellinger of 39 West Monroe street passed away at his home shortly after 2:30 o'clock this morning, following a long illness. He was 73 years of age and one of this city's most respected citizens. Deceased was born on the old Bellinger homestead on what is known as Fall Hill, to the southwest of the city. He followed the vocation of farming until 1880, when he removed to this city with his family, where he has since resided. He was a man of strict probity of character and upright in his business dealings. He is survived by a widow, two sons, John and George Bellinger, both of this city, also by three daughters, Mrs. Charles Bellinger of Amsterdam, Mrs. E. A. Nelson and Mrs. Charles H. Trask of this city. The funeral will be held from his late home at 2:30 o'clock next Tuesday afternoon, the Rev. J. [Julian] E. Cutler [Universalist] officiating.
