DEATH OF MISS JULIA A. BELLINGER AT THE AGE OF 65 YEARS

Fort Plain, Oct 13.—Miss Julia A. Bellinger, aged 65 years, died at the home of her brother, Theron Bellinger, in this village, yesterday forenoon. About 18 months ago Miss Bellinger sustained a slight stroke of paralysis, and although never free from the effects of this illness, she had recovered sufficiently to be about and her death was not expected. She had been at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Walrath in this town of Thursday and was taken ill there. She was at once brought to her brother's home, where she gradually failed until the end. Death was due to hemorrhage of the brain. The deceased was born in this town and had always lived here. She was a daughter of the late Christian and Elvina Bellinger, the family being one of the oldest and best known in this section. She was a member of the Universalist Church and was held in high esteem and respect by a large circle of friends and acquaintances. Besides the brother mentioned, Miss Bellinger is survived by one sister, Mrs. Asa Zimmerman, who lives in this town. A prayer service will be held from the late home on Sunday afternoon on Sunday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock and funeral services will be held from the Catharine Nellis Memorial Chapel at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Herbert Frank Moulton, D.D., pastor of the local Universalist church, officiating. The interment will be made in Fort Plain Cemetery.
