GEORGE W. BENEDICT

Former Resident of Village Dead in Schenectady

Fort Plain, May 24.—George W. Benedict died at Ellis Hospital, Schenectady, Wednesday night, after passing through an operation, aged 62 years. The deceased spent the greater portion of his lifetime in Fort Plain. For the past two years he had resided in Ilion and Schenectady. He was a veteran on the Civil War. He was also a member of Mohawk Valley Lodge No. 66, K. of P. of this village. The officials of the order have received the news of his death yesterday afternoon, and will have charge of the funeral obsequies, which will be held from the Universalist church to-morrow at 1:30, the Rev. J. L. Richards officiating. The remains will arrive on the train reaching Fort Plain station at 11:23.

The deceased is survived by his widow [Jane Hotaling Benedict] and one son [Adelbert], who resides in New York City.
