C. Fred Betts, chief editorial writer of the Syracuse Herald-Journal and Herald-American, died July 16. The son of an illustrious father, Dr. Frederick W. During his lifetime, he had been active, not only in his church, but in civic and community life, and was known and respected by the political leaders of both major parties for his truthful reporting.
