Maria F. Bigelow, Active in Church

Mrs. Maria F. Bigelow, who was in charge of altar flowers in All Souls Universalist Church for 22 years, died yesterday of pneumonia in the Midwood Sanitarium. She was 62 and lived at 649 E. 24th St.

For 25 years Mrs. Bigelow made it her custom to present flowers to every child christened in All Souls Church. Mr. and Mrs. Bigelow joined the church during the pastorate of the Rev. Dr. L. Ward Brigham. She is survived by her husband, Edwin H. Bigelow; her daughter, Mrs. Albert L. [Marjorie] Brewster, who also is active in the work of the church, and two sisters, Miss Alice A. Foster, who is deaconess of All Souls Church, and Mrs. Charles E. Smith.

The Rev. Cornelius Greenway, pastor of the church, will officiate at the funeral services in the Fairchild Chapel, 86 Lefferts Place, at 2:30 p.m. Sunday. Interment will be private.
