Fort Plain, Jan. 12.—The funeral of Albert Billington was held at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Raymond Young, in this village, yesterday at 12 o'clock, the Rev. Herbert F. Moulton, D.D., pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. The body was taken to Ephrata for interment. Mr. Billington was 75 years of age and had lived in the Wagner's Hollow section of the town of Palatine for many years. Of late he had been spending part of his time at the home of Romaine Saltsman. He started out to feed the chickens Friday and neighbors saw him fall to the ground. They hastened to his assistance and found him unconscious. Medical aid was summoned but he died a short time later, death being due to heart trouble. The body was brought to the undertaking parlors of Adam C. Swartz in this village and was later taken to the home of the daughter. The survivors are two sons and two daughters, Menzo Billington and Mrs. Maggie Tanner of Little Falls, Mrs. Raymond Young of this village and Albert Billington of Palatine.
