Charles Billington

Fort Plain, Oct. 14.—Charles Billington, aged 37 years, died at his home in Nelliston Saturday morning, following a long illness. Mr. Billington had been in poor health for a number of years as the result of a kidney trouble and about two weeks ago he was taken ill, the case finally developing into bronchial pneumonia. He was a well known young man of pleasing disposition and had a large circle of friends. He is survived by his wife [Lela], one son, Harold Billington [about 14 years old]; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Billington, and two sisters, Mrs. Harold [Ida M.] Lampman, and Mrs. Andrew [Libbie] Melick, all of Nelliston. The funeral will be held at the home Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. Herbert F. Moulton, D.D., pastor of the Universalist church of this village, officiating. Interment will be in the Fort Plain cemetery.
