Harold Bills Dies; Was War Veteran

Harold R. Bills, 47, died early Thursday morning at his home, 8 Mutchler Street. He was born Sept. 25, 1917 in Dolgeville, the son of Myron and Nellie Brown bills and had also lived here. He served four years in the Air Force during World War 2 in the Seventh Airways Communication System. He attended the Universalist Church of Dolgeville and was a member of Dolgeville Masonic Lodge. Mr. Bills had been employed for a number of years by the Chicago Pneumatic Tool Co. in Utica.

On Sept. 24, 1943 he was married to Elizabeth Richardson in Hawkinsville, Ga. She survives, with one son, Robert, a student at Oswego State Teachers College; and his parents, at home; nieces, nephews and cousins.
