Henry Blackmar Dies; Civil War Veteran

Henry C. Blackmar, a veteran of the Civil War, in which he served in the 83d Pennsylvania Volunteers as a sergeant, died today at his home, 30 Kenmore Place. He was born in West Springfield, Pa., 85 years ago and was the husband of the late Jane A. Tuthill. Mr. Blackmar was formerly an inspector in the customs department, retiring after 20 years' service. He was a member of George Ricard Post, G.A.R., and formerly resided in the Eastern District. He is survived by two daughters, the Misses Edna M. and Lillian A. Blackmar; a son, Elbert E., who is postmaster at Ketchikan, Alaska, and a daughter-in-law, Mrs. Harry T. Blackmar. Services will be conducted by the Rev. Cornelius Greenway, pastor of All Souls Universalist Church, on Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock.
