MRS. LUCINDA BLISS OF MOHAWK,
AGED 80, DIES FROM FALL

Mohawk, Dec. 10—Mrs. Lucinda L. Bliss, a highly esteemed resident, passed away yesterday at her home, (4?) Ann street. Several months ago Mrs. Bliss fell, breaking her hip, never fully recovered. Prior to her death she had been confined for several weeks in the Ilion hospital.

She was born in the town of German Flatts, November (3?), 1845, daughter of the late William W. Gifford and Ruth W. Wood. She was married to Levi Bliss, Dec. 31, 1863. He preceded her in death by over nine years. They followed farming during the early part of their lives, moving to Herkimer in 1869. After the death of her husband Mrs. Bliss came to Mohawk, where she has since resided.

Mrs. Bliss was a member of Myrtle Chapter, O.E.S. of Herkimer, and Woman's Relief Corps. She attended the Universalist Church. Surviving are a son, John R. Bliss of Herkimer; a sister, Mrs. Alma Wood of Minnesota; and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral was held from the home Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. D. [DeWitt] C. Reilly of the Universalist Church of Herkimer officiating. Interment will be made in Oak Hill Cemetery.
