Volney Orlando Bliss, well known Schuyler Lake man, died Tuesday night at 9:30 at Binghamton State hospital from a blood clot and heart attack. He was born at Schuyler Lake December 7th, 1872, a son of Henry and Ada (Freeman) Bliss. He was a photographer for years at Oneonta, but for the past twelve years had lived here with his sister, Mrs. Inez Flansburg. He had been in poor health for several years and was taken to Binghamton for treatment three months ago. Surviving are the sister; two other sisters, Miss Margaret Bliss, who also lived at the Flansburg home, and Mrs. L. J. Downs of Little Falls, and four brothers, George of Elkinburg, Canada, Morgan of Hartford, Conn., Harry and Devere of Herkimer, several nephews, nieces, and cousins. The funeral will be held from the home of his sister, Mrs. Flansburg, Friday at 2:30. The Rev. H. [Howard] B. Gilman [Universalist] will officiate. Burial will be in the family plot in Schuyler Lake cemetery.
