Charles S. Bloss

Charles S. Bloss, 80, retired farmer, of 123 Main street in Penn Yan, died at Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Hospital Tuesday night, July 27, 1954.

Mr. Bloss leaves his wife, Mrs. Lois Foster Bloss and one son, Harold L. Bloss of Whitesville.

He was born in the Town of Willing, Allegany county on Sept. 5, 1873, the son of Elisha and Lucinda Brown Bloss. Mr. Bloss was a resident of Whitesville until 1919, and for the past 34 years has resided in Penn Yan. He operated farms in Barrington and on West Lake Keuka road, retiring in 1950.

Mr. Bloss was a member of Barrington Grange, the Yates County Pomona Grange, and was assessor of the Town of Barrington for nine years. He had been a member of the Universalist church in Whitesville since 1905.

Funeral service will be held at the residence of his son, Harold Bloss, in Whitesville on Saturday, July 31, at 2 p.m.
