Milton Bloss Dies; Funeral Service is Held Here on Monday

Milton E. Bloss, a resident of Bluff Point, Keuka Lake and a former resident of Whitesville, died on Friday, March 10, following a 10-day illness. Funeral services were held from the home of his brother, Harold L. Bloss, in Whitesville, on Monday, with burial in the family plot in the Independence Cemetery.

Mr. Bloss left Whitesville in 1919 and has since resided in Yates County. He was active in Grange work, having been a farmer his entire lifetime. He served for two terms as Master of the Barrington, Yate County, Grange. He was a member of the Universalist Church of Whitesville.

Born December 1, 1897, he was a son of Charles S. and Lois Foster Bloss, and is survived by his parents and one brother, H. L. Bloss.
