Blanche Bowers [Blowers], Fort Plain, Dies

FORT PLAIN—Blanche Blowers, 61, widow of Arthur Blowers, died Saturday morning at the home of [her] sister, Mrs. Leon Perry, 12 Judson St., Binghamton, following a lingering illness.
