CHARLES S. BOOTH

Charles Sumner Booth died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. James F. Wheeler, 22 Locust street, Norwich, yesterday afternoon.

Mr. Booth was born January 17, 1874 in Limerick, N.Y., the son of Charles and [Annelin?] Canfield Booth. On September 18, 1896 he married Lena Underwood, who died September 21, 1942.

For many years Mr. Booth was a merchant in Dexter, N.Y. He had made his home with his daughter for several months.

Mr. Booth was a member and trustee of the First Universalist church of Dexter. He was also a member of F&AM 1073, Sacketts Harbor chapter R.A.M., 68, K.T. No. 11, Media Temple, Watertown and IOOF No. 767, Watertown. He was a past grand of this order.

Besides his daughter he is survived by a sister, Mrs. Frank Dennie of Limerick; two nieces, Mrs. Stella Allen and Mrs. Ray Ellison, both of Limerick. He is also survived by one grandchild, Mark Foster, of Norwich.

The body rests at the home of his niece, Mrs. Stanley Fetter, 706 South Hamilton street, Watertown, from where a prayer service will be held at 1:15 p.m. Friday, with the Rev. Dr. Harold H. Niles, officiating.

Burial will be in the Dexter cemetery, Dexter.
