

[Bork, Minnie Felton]

Mrs. Minnie Felton Bork, 70, wife of Daniel E. Bork, died early this morning at a Utica hospital where she had been confined for the past month. She had been in failing health for the past two years and seriously ill for two months. She was a lifelong resident of the town of Lee, having been born here Sept. 11, 1865, a daughter of the late Elan and Mary Felton. On Jan. 24, 1885, she was married to Daniel E. Bork, the ceremony being performed by the late Rev. Mr. Door of Delta. For the past 13 years she had lived on the Bork Road, Lorena. She was a charter member and a past matron of Lake Delta Chapter 590 OES and was very active in chapter work as long as her health permitted. She was a Universalist in faith but for the past several years had attended the Rome Baptist Church [e.g. because the Universalist congregation had disbanded]. Surviving besides her husband is a nephew, Ralph Harrington, of New York City.
