MRS. AGNES BORLAND

Mrs. Agnes Sitts Borland, aged 89, died unexpectedly Wednesday of last week at her home in Richfield Springs.

She was born May 14, 1862 on the former Black farm in the Town of Richfield, a daughter of Anson and Elizabeth (Austick) Sitts. She attended the Goodyear Seminary there and was active in amateur plays for a number of years. Her marriage to Dr. W. P. Borland took place in her home Apr. 28, 1897 with the Rev. S. R. Ward of the Universalist church officiating. Dr. Borland died December 5, 1929.

Mrs. Borland was a member and active worker in the Universalist Church during its existence here. She later attended St. John's Church where she was a member of the Rector's Aid Society.

The funeral was held at 2 p.m. Saturday from the McGrath Funeral Home, the Rev. Daniel T. Hill, rector of St. John's Episcopal Church, officiating. Burial was in Lake View Cemetery, Richfield Springs.
