HENRY H. BOSWORTH

Ogdensburg, March 7.—Henry H. Bosworth died at his home in this city Saturday night after a long illness of heart disease, at the age of 68 years. He was born in Keeseville, Essex county. He came to this city before the war and entered the employ of the Ashley hardware store. When the call to arms came he enlisted and after serving out his enlistment returned to this city and re-entered the employ of the Ashley store, remaining there until his health began to fail a year or so ago, when he retired. He had been in the employ of the same concern or its successors for more than 55 years, which is a unique record. He was a member of the Universalist church, Ogdensburg Lodge No. 128, F.& A.M., and the Grand Army. He leaves a widow but no children. A brother, John C., lives at Lincoln, Neb., and a sister, Mrs. J. W. Pruitt, at Oklahoma City. The funeral will probably be held Tuesday.
