BOUGHTON

Charles F. Boughton, a highly esteemed resident of Victor township, passed away at his farm home, Monday afternoon, January 10, 1938, after an illness of about a week. He was a man of fine character and kindly disposition and many hearts are saddened by his death. Charles F. Boughton was born 73 years ago, in the house in which death came to him and from which his parents, the late Edward and Harriet Farnham Boughton, later moved their family to the adjoining farm, now occupied by their son, Linus C. Boughton. At the time of their marriage, March 13, 1889, Charles F. Boughton and his bride, Jennie Bennett, established their home at his birthplace, and have operated the farm throughout their married life. Mr. Boughton was a trustee of the Boughton Hill cemetery, a trustee of St. Paul's Universalist Parish and a member of the Victor Grange. He was a descendant of the pioneer Boughtons who came from Connecticut to this section in 1788.

The surviving relatives besides the widow, are a daughter, Mrs. Gilbert W. Aldridge; a sister, Mrs. Charles A. Phillips; two brothers, John H. and Linus C., and six grandchildren, Mary, Albert, Carolyn, Ruth, Esther and Gilbert Jr. Aldridge, all of Victor. Funeral services were conducted from the home, Thursday afternoon, the Rev. Nelson L. Lobdell officiating. Burial was made in the Boughton Hill cemetery.
