Death's Harvest

Lucien B. Bowen died at his home in Oneonta [on] Friday [April 26] in the 70th year of his age, after several weeks' illness. He was born in Middlefield [on] June 20, 1842, a son of the late Levi and Anna Richardson Bowen. He resided there until 1894, when he removed to Oneonta. In Middlefield Mr. Bowen filled many positions of trust, including that of supervisor for several years and town clerk. He was a prominent farmer, a Democrat, and highly regarded by his neighbors. His brother, the late Samuel A. Bowen, was formerly county judge of this county [Otsego]. Mr. Bowen married Augusta J. Russell of Buffalo, and of their union three children survive: Levi B. Bowen of Oneonta, Mrs. H. W. Scott of Brooklyn, and Lucien H. Bowen of Cooperstown. He is also survived by his second wife, who was Mrs. Josephine Munson McMinn of Oneonta; by a brother, E. E. Bowen of Middlefield, and a sister, Mrs. A. C. Shipman, of Cooperstown. The funeral was held Monday morning [April 29] and the body brought to Cooperstown for interment in Lakewood cemetery. Rev. W. [Wm.] G. Cortright of Cooperstown [a Universalist] officiated at the funeral service.
