Lewis County Notes.

Washington Bowen died Saturday at his home in the western part of this town, aged 80 years. Mr. Bowen was long a resident of Martinsburg, but removed to Lowville about 20 years ago. His entire life was devoted to farming. Mr. Bowen was a good citizen, a gentleman of more than ordinary intelligence, and for several years had contributed more or less to the local press. His wife [Julia *Elliott* Bowen] died about four years ago [in 1890]. He leaves one son, Clement Bowen, of Martinsburg, and two daughters, Mrs. John [Alma] Taylor of West Martinsburg and Mrs. Henry [Lois] Bradt of Lowville. Mr. Bowen was a strong Universalist and a good Bible scholar. Rev. G. [George] S. Weaver, of Canton, has been engaged to conduct his funeral services, which will be held from the house tomorrow at 1 P.M.
