JOHN E. BRADLEY

One of the most loyal and devoted members of the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church in Albion was John E. Bradley whose death occurred on October 20, 1948 in his eighty-third year. The memorial service was conducted by the Rev. Donald W. Lawson.

Mr. Bradley was born on a farm in Albion and had made farming his vocation for many years. He was married to Miss Alice Johnston in 1891 and then was employed as field representative of the Burt Olney Canning Company in Albion. Later he occupied a similar position with the Quaker Maid Canning Company in Brockport, serving until his retirement in 1947. Mrs. Bradley's death occurred in 1945.

He was a prominent Republican in Orleans County, having served as treasurer of the County Committee. He served his church as steward for many years. He made the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church the residuary legatee of his estate.
