Obituary.

Miss Mariette Brainard, at the age of 75, passed to the higher life Jan. 22, 1893, from her home in Hubbardsville, where her whole life had been spent on the farm where her father, Ezra Brainard, settled coming from Connecticut when all the land was an unbroken forest. She was a sister of the late Diodate Brainard and Austin Brainard, who is now over four score years, and the only surviving member of a family of six children [the other three having been Oliver, Olive, and Amaziah Brainard]. She also leaves several nephews and nieces. Deceased was an invalid since her 18th year and although living a very quiet life she remembered the poor and always gave freely of her means. In religion [she was ] a Universalist and an attendant of that church when health would permit. She was a constant reader of *The Christian Leader* for many years and willingly loaned them for others to enjoy. Funeral services were held at the house Jan. 24, conducted by her pastor, Rev. Mr. Fuller. Many thanks are due the friends who assisted with care and sympathy in the last illness and at the funeral. Their kindness is appreciated and will be gratefully remembered by her relatives.
