DEATH AT FORT PLAIN

Mrs. John Brand Dies After Long Illness
—Was Highly Esteemed in the Village

FORT PLAIN, Oct. 5.—Mrs. John [Alice] Brand, a well known and respected resident of this village, is dead at her home here, following a long illness. For the past two weeks recovery seemed very doubtful.
